



Composite Rotor Blade Service Technician (Shop)

The primary responsibility of this position is to repair and restore wind turbine blades. The technician will repair blades using a variety of grinding, sanding and composite fiberglass laminating techniques.

The work is performed at our Goderich location. The usual work pattern is Monday to Friday for a total of forty hours per week. Our start rate is \$14.00 per hour and employer paid benefits are provided after four months of employment.

Candidates are expected to live in Goderich or the immediate area, or to be prepared to relocate within this area during the first four months of employment.

Basic Requirements - (Candidates without these criteria will not be considered)

- Grade 12 graduation or an alternate combination of education and experience acceptable to Complete Wind.
- The ability to comprehend and follow written and verbal instructions provided in
 - English.
- A commitment to working safely, and following all safety practices and protocols.
- The ability to wear a respirator for extended periods of time.
- A commitment to promoting a positive, productive and harassment free workplace.
- A commitment to regular, reliable, and timely attendance.

Physical Capabilities – (Candidates must possess certain basic physical abilities as required of the position)

- Able to bend, kneel, squat and climb ladders as well as stand for extended periods.
- Able to comfortably work in enclosed or confined spaces.
- Able to lift weight up to 25 Kg.

Preferential consideration will be given to candidates who have had specific training or experience working with composites and/or blade repair, or worked in a repair or manufacturing factory or shop.
